Content Concerns about Social Media: Education Yourself and Apply God's Word

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Third, talk about how each show/app/website/game may or may not be a good fit for you and your family based on the application of God's Word to your lives. As parents, have the "tough" conversations from a place of love with your kids, and then, make a decision in about each one.

- Should it be cut out completely?
- Should you provide guidance for your child each time he/she watches/plays, etc?
- Do you need to dig in to learn more about each one before making the call?
