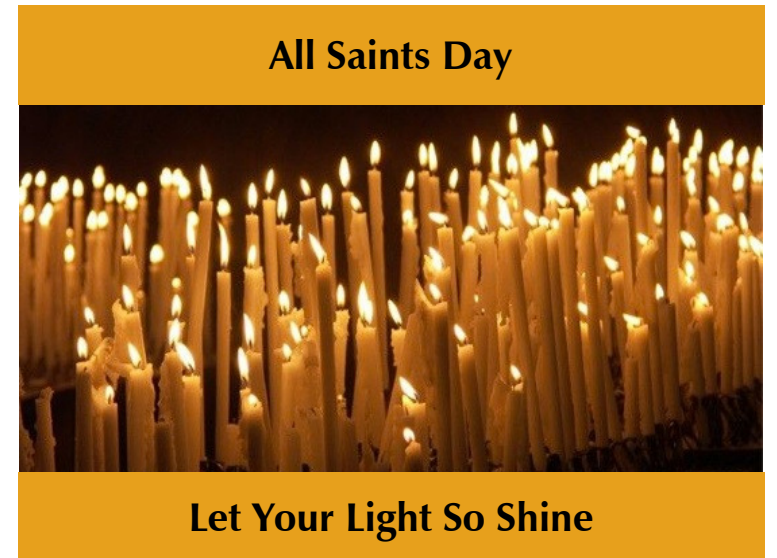

When Enough is Enough

This morning, our Bible text from Luke 12:13-21 initiates a conversation that urges us to consider the issues of possessions, their influence upon our relationship with God, gratitude, and how we live as disciples. In other words, we're asking, "When is enough *enough*?"

Gratitude helps us consider and live into the question of how we deal with possessions. Gratitude fosters an understanding that what we have is given by God, that there *is* enough, and that we are called to use what we have been given for ministry in family, church, community, and the world. Gratitude initiates a response of joy rather than want, of thanksgiving rather than a continued desire for more.
