Steve is a doctor and coordinator for 10 medical clinics which serve nomadic Maasai people in remote areas. Steve is fortunate to work alongside 15 motivated and competent Tanzanian doctors as well. The clinics are located near permanent water sources and are the only medical care opportunities available. They provide free immunizations, prenatal care, and various forms of contraception. Diseases such as malaria, tuberculosis, trachoma, anemia, vitamin deficiencies and malnutrition are also treated. The largest of these clinics is located in Mto Wa Mbu and provides long-term treatment for over 1000 HIV patients.
