SERMON | God and Freedom TEACHER | Pastor Tim Boettger TEXT | Luke 4:18-21 & John 8:31-36

#### Synopsis

As we celebrate our nation's Independence Day, let us explore the nuanced topic of freedom. God mentions freedom many times and in various ways throughout the Scriptures. What does the word freedom bring to mind for you? How important do you think freedom is to God? Consider these questions as we discover the truths God has revealed in his word about freedom.

- Does this passage teach you about who God is?
- What does this mean for the Church as a whole?

# **READ, RUMINATE, AND REMEMBER**

#### Luke 4:18-19

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor.

Jesus is reciting from the prophet Isaiah, explaining how the "Anointed One" is to come bringing good news, healing, and liberation. Jesus declares that these aspects of the prophecy are being fulfilled as a part of the Messiah's earthly ministry. This is a celebratory announcement that the time of God's salvation has arrived. This week as we celebrate our Independence Day, let us remember and celebrate God's salvation!

## 2023-2024 Highland School Year Recap

The final Partners in Education (PIE) activity with Highland School was held in May when Partners' volunteers hosted an appreciation lunch, courtesy of Nazareth and catered from Nazareth's kitchen for the entire (100 professional and non-professional) Highland staff. We all enjoyed great food and camaraderie that day. Staff, again, expressed their sincere gratitude for the meal and for Nazareth's involvement with Highland School throughout the years.

Thank you to all who saved HyVee receipts from Cedar Falls, Waterloo, and Waverly stores this past year. We do not yet know how much cash will be returned to Highland from the HyVee receipts. We do know we will learn at our first monthly meeting with Partners in August if they will continue with Cash 4 Students. For your information, the program was initiated by HyVee in 2013 and through the 2021-2022 school year, had given nearly \$1,000,000 back to 89 participating schools in the state, averaging \$775 per school. Start saving and hold your HyVee receipts now (beginning with June 1, 2024), if you wish, to be ahead of the late summer announcement regarding participation.
