

SERMON | The Antidote to Unceasing Anguish
TEACHER | Pastor Mike Brost
TEXT | Romans 9:1-24 & Romans 9:25-10:4

Synopsis

We all suffer to various extents in our lives. By exploring Romans Chapter 9, we learn how Paul discovered the antidote to his "sorrow and unceasing anguish." Through our faith, we can find it, too!

Digest The Word

Read the scripture passages from the Service and reflect on the sermon and on these questions to help you live out God's Word in your everyday life.

- · How did the sermon challenge/encourage you?
- · Does this passage teach you about who God is?
- · What are the personal implications for you?
- · What does this mean for the Church as a whole?

READ, RUMINATE, AND REMEMBER

Philippians 1:6

And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

God alone started the work of grace, our sanctification, and only he can finish the good work that He started. That work of grace is rooted in the divine goodness of the Father. We find eternal security in the fact that it was God who saved us when we could not save ourselves. Paul refers to the completion of the work of sanctification in this verse. Has God's good work begun in your life? If not, consider what is holding you back from embracing faith in Christ, and listen for God's ever-present yet quiet voice. If your Christian journey has begun, what has been the most challenging and rewarding aspects? How can you personally allow God to guide your life?
