Register For Our Baptism Class



📚 MUSIC SPOTLIGHT

At Nazareth, we want to lift up vibrant, congregational singing as an integral part of our time together on Sunday mornings. Using Spotify, these "Music Spotlights" are designed to encourage us and help familiarize us with most or all of the music selections for the upcoming weekend so that we can wholeheartedly sing in full voice as we worship together.

This coming weekend, we will sing "How Great Thou Art," - a hymn that has a modest beginning but has gained worldwide fame. It started as a poem written by Carl Boberg, a 26-year-old Swedish minister, in 1885; the text for the hymn was published and "forgotten" - or so Boberg thought - until he heard it being sung to the tune of an old Swedish melody. Eventually, the hymn spread to Russia, where English missionary, Stuart Hine, heard it; Hine was so moved that he modified and expanded the text into the arrangement we know today. Sometime later, Dr. J. Edwin Orr, an Irish-American Baptist minister, heard it being sung by the Naga Tribespeople of India. When Orr introduced it at a conference, it came to the attention of a music publisher who contacted Stuart Hine to have the hymn copyrighted, published, and recorded. Finally, during a Billy Graham Crusade in Toronto, the hymn was presented to famed gospel singer, George Beverly Shea; although Shea initially ignored the suggestion and the hymn didn't initially gain much traction, eventually it was popularized to the delight of Crusade attendees – who purportedly sang it 99 times – during a Crusade in New York City in 1957.

Navigating Family Conflict


