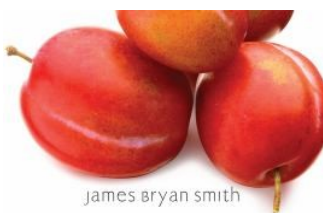


Lent Small Group Leaders are needed!
